



TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATING

The contractual relations between the Organisers and the Exhibitor are governed by these Terms and Conditions, a condensed summary of the General Terms and Conditions for Participation in Exhibitions organised by mfora BV.

1. NAME

3. FREQUENCY

4. ORGANIZATION

Organisers reserve the right to modify assembling and dismantling periods and times if they so deems fit.

6. SECTORS

Organisers offer the exhibitor exhibition space for rent based on 4 different stand packs, in addition to specific sponsorship and stand pack opportunities. The focus of the event is on Additive Manufacturing Technologies, Additive Manufacturing Services, Digital Manufacturing Technologies, Digital Manufacturing Services, Digital Parts Production Facilities, Engineering Services, Parts Management Systems, Digital Warehousing and Catalogue Services, and PLM solutions. Organisers reserve the right to withdraw any products and services that do not fit in any of the sectors included in the event.

7. PARTICIPATION FEES

8. VALUE ADDED TAX (VAT)

All prices and fees are subject to the applicable VAT (Value Added Tax) based on European Regulations.

9. PAYMENT TERMS

After having sent the Confirmation of Participation, the Organisers will issue an invoice with the following payment deadlines:

- within 15 days after issuing the invoice, a first payment corresponding to 30% of the total amount
- 135 days before assembly starts, the second payment corresponding to 70% of the total amount

Should the invoice be issued within the period of 135 days before the assembly starts, payment of the total invoice is due within 30 days after the issue date. In all cases, invoices must have been paid in full before assembly starts.

10. CO-EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors may authorise other companies to join their stand as co-exhibitors, in which case a registration fee of €495.00 will apply.

11. DISTRIBUTION AND ALLOCATION OF SPACES

As from January 4, 2022, the Organisers process of distributing and allocation will start in order of submitted applications.

12. CONFIRMATION OF PARTICIPATION

The registration for an exhibition stand pack and eventual further services must be made in writing on the form provided for this purpose with a legally binding signature. The exhibits are to be described and at the Organisers' request descriptions are to be provided. By signing the application form, the exhibitor accepts the terms and conditions of business and participation as binding. The registration is put into effect upon sending of the Confirmation of Participation by Organisers. This Confirmation of Participation includes the stand location and number, in addition to the general and specific terms and technical conditions. Deviating terms and conditions on the part of exhibitors are not acknowledged.

13. FORCE MAJEURE

Organisers reserve the right to postpone the assembly, duration and dismantling period of the event under special circumstances or circumstances beyond their control. Tickets as well as exhibitor and sponsorship packages remain valid for the alternative date. In case a critical situation should arise from COVID-19 and in any other case of force majeure, the exhibitor shall not have the right to cancel the contract or to claim damages.

14. CANCELLATION BY THE EXHIBITOR

Exhibitors may cancel their participation by sending per mail or post a cancellation notice. If the cancellation is sent the month before the introduction webinars will be organised, the amounts paid by the exhibitor up to that point will be refunded.

For cancellation after the first introduction webinar, the exhibitor is obliged to pay the invoiced amount.

15. LIABILITIES

Claims for compensation and claims for reimbursement of expenses of the exhibitor are ruled out. This does not hold in case the Organisers are liable by law, especially in case of malice, gross negligence, violation of life, body or health or in case of violation of essential contractual obligations. The exhibitor is liable for all damages caused by him, his employees, and his representatives. The exhibitor is solely responsible for the legal admissibility of data and pictures used in publications provided at the event, as well as for ensuring that no industrial property rights such as trademarks and copyrights of third parties are being violated.

16. DATA PROTECTION

Personal data provided by the exhibitor and participant upon event registration will be recorded, stored and processed exclusively for event management purposes of this and following events. By event registration, the exhibitor and participant agrees to the storage and the forwarding and the use of these data in a publicly accessible list of exhibitors and participants.

17. SEVERABILITY

If any term or other provision of these Terms and Conditions is determined to be invalid, illegal or incapable of being enforced by any rule or law, or public policy all other conditions and provisions of these Terms and Conditions shall nevertheless remain in full force and effect so long as the economic or legal substance of the transactions contemplated hereby is not elected in any manner materially adverse to any party.

18. APPLICABLE LAW

These Terms and Conditions shall be interpreted and construed according to, and governed by, the laws of The Netherlands, excluding any such laws that might direct the application of another jurisdiction.
